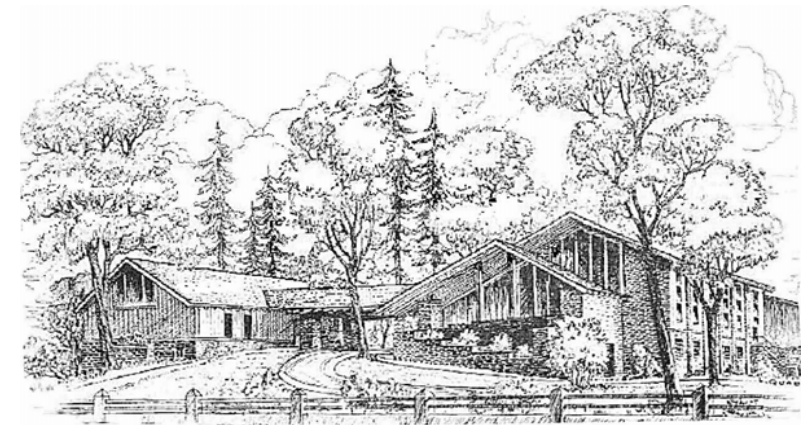

Internationally Acclaimed Musician

ROMAYNE WHEELER

Will give a piano concert

in the St. Helena Seventh-day Adventist Church

Mr. Wheeler studied music in Salzburg and Vienna, graduating as a composer and pianist. He has performed as a concert artist, touring throughout the United States, Mexico, Canada, Europe, the Near East, China and Taiwan. Mr. Wheeler is a great nephew of Angwin's Lois Berry, and brother to author Joe Wheeler and artist Marjorie Raymond Wheeler. The family is gathering to celebrate Aunt Lois' 104th birthday.

Since 1992 Romaine Wheeler has lived among the Tarahumara (Rarámuri) Indians in the state of Chihuahua, Mexico, hauling a Steinway grand piano onto the cliffs in the little community which is 80 miles from the nearest town. He currently sponsors over 30 children in secondary education and college. One young man, 19 year old Romayno Gutiérrez Luna, finishes college this year and is going on to study piano and composition professionally, combining his knowledge of classical and baroque music, and adding interpretation of his native music on the piano. Romaine Wheeler and the Tarahumara Indians were the subject of a French documentary which won an award last year, "The Pianist from the Sierra Madre."
