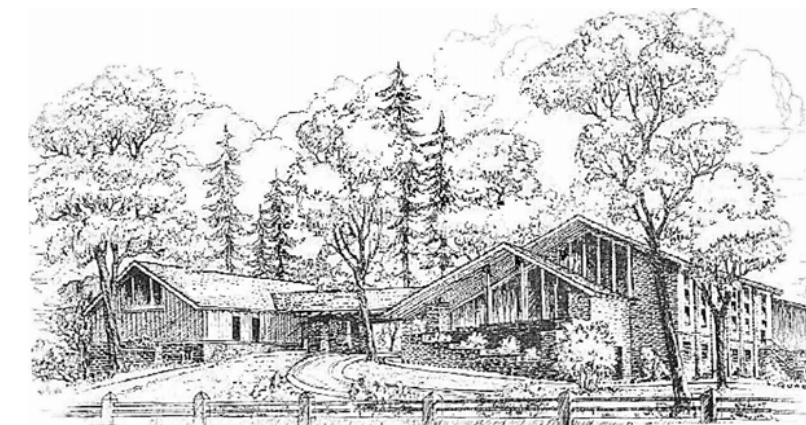


Picture of Church Budget through 7-21-07
