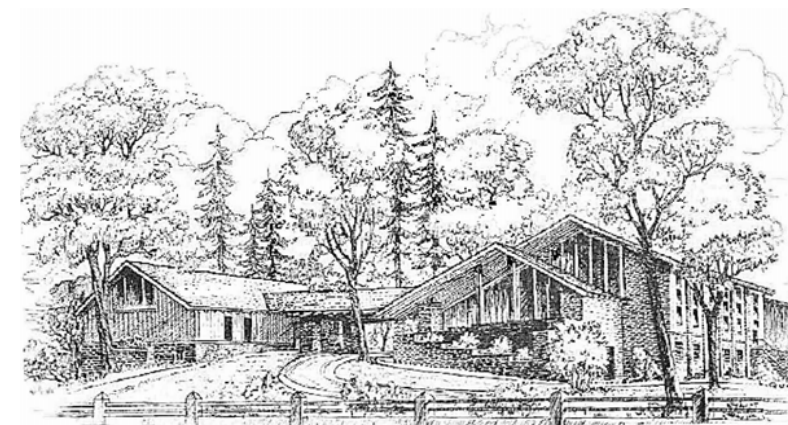


Picture of Church Budget through 7-28-07
