

BIBLE PROMISES

Heb 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

Mark 6:31 Come with me to a quiet place and rest.

Psalms 28:7 KJV The LORD is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoices; and with my song will I praise him.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart; and lean not unto your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct your paths.

John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

Nahum 1:7 The Lord is Good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him.

2Kings 20:5 'Thus says the LORD, the God of David your father: "I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; surely I will heal you."

Psalms 27:4-5 One thing I ask of the LORD,
this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple. For in the day of trouble
he will keep me safe in his dwelling;
he will hide me in the shelter of his tabernacle and set me high upon a rock.

John 6:37 All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.

Jeremiah 31:3 The LORD has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.

Psalms 100:5 For the LORD is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation.

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that

Phil 4:6-7 Do not be anxious about anything, but by prayer and petitioned, with thanksgiving present your request to God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:6 NLT Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. 7 If you do this, you will experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the human mind can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

Mark 10:27 But Jesus looked at them and said, "With men it is impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible."

Hab 2:4 Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked; but the righteous will live by their faith. For the just shall live by faith.

Romans 10:12 Jew and Gentile are the same in this respect. They all have the same Lord, who generously gives his riches to all who ask for them. 13 For "Anyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

1Corinthians 2:9 ...it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him"- NIV

Isaiah 9:2 The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned.

Is. 40:29-31 He gives power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increases strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy- meditate on these things.

1Corinthians 14:33 For God is not a God of disorder but of peace.

Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Exodus 33:14 And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

Psalms. 9:10 All those who know your mercy, Lord, will count on you for help. For you have never forsaken those who trust in you.

Psalms 17:8 Guard me as the apple of your eye. Hide me in the shadow of your wings.

Hebrews 4:15 & 16 For we have not a high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

1 John 5:14-15 This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that if he hears us- whatever we ask- we know that we have what we asked of him.

2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.

Psalms 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet, And a light to my path.

Luke 11:9-10 So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

Psalms 105:4-5 Look to the LORD and his strength; seek his face always. Remember the wonders he has done, his miracles, and the judgments he pronounced.

Isaiah 41:10-13 Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.' For I, the LORD your God, will hold your right hand, Saying to you, 'Fear not, I will help you.'

Isaiah 42:16 I will bring the blind by a way they did not know; I will lead them in paths they have not known. I will make darkness light before them, And crooked places straight. These things I will do for them, And not forsake them.

Proverbs 30:5 Every word of God is pure;
He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him.

Psalms 103:13-14 As a father pities his children, So the LORD pities those who fear Him. For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust.

James 4:7-8 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Deuteronomy 31:8 "And the LORD, He is the One who goes before you. He will be with you, He will not leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed."

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.

2 Chronicles 20:15 And he said, "Listen, all you of Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you, King Jehoshaphat! Thus says the LORD to you: 'Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God's.'

Deuteronomy 20:1 "When you go out to battle against your enemies, and see horses and chariots and people more numerous than you, do not be afraid of them; for the LORD your God is with you.

Psalms 73:23-24 Nevertheless I am continually with You; You hold me by my right hand. You will guide me with Your counsel, And afterward receive me to glory.

Deuteronomy 20:3-4 'Hear, O Israel: Today you are on the verge of battle with your enemies. Do not let your heart faint, do not be afraid, and do not tremble or be terrified because of them; for the LORD your God is He who goes with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you.'

Psalms 46:1-2 God is our refuge and strength, a tested help in times of trouble. And so we need not fear even if the world blows up, and the mountains crumble into the sea.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

2 Samuel 22:31 As for God, His way is perfect; The word of the Lord is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him.

Psalms. 56:3-4 When I am afraid, I will trust in you. In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do to me.

Psalms. 32:8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way, which you should go: I will guide you and watch over you.

2 Cor 5:7 For we walk by faith, not by sight

Jeremiah 33:3 Call upon me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you know not.

Psalms 91:12-15 For he shall give his angels charge over you, to keep you in all you ways. They shall bear you up in their hands, lest you dash your foot against a stone. You shall tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shall you trample under feet. Because he has set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. Psalms 37: 23, 24 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delights in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholds him with his hand. Guidance

Psalms 31:3 For you are my rock and my fortress; therefore for your name's sake lead me, and guide me.

Psalms 48:14 For this God is our God forever and ever: he will be our guide even until the day we die.

Psalms 105:8 Though a thousand generations pass, he never forgets his promises.

Isaiah 54:10 For the mountains may depart and the hills disappear, but my kindness shall not leave you. My promises of peace for you will never be broken, says the Lord who has mercy upon you

Luke 12:32 Fear not, little flock, for it gives your Father great pleasure to give you the Kingdom of Heaven.

Psalms 125:1 Those who trust in the Lord are steady as Mount Zion, unmoved by any circumstance.

Psalmsa 40:3 And he has put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.

2 Peter 4:1 Whereby are given to us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these we might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Psalms 17:8 Keep me as the apple of your eye; Hide me under the shadow of Your wings.

Psalms 84:11-12 For God is our Light and our Protector. He gives Grace and glory. No good thing will he withhold from those who walk along his paths. **O** Lord of the armies of heaven, blessed are those who trust in you.

1 Peter 5:7 Let him have all your worries and cares, for he is always thinking about you and watching everything that concerns you.

Proverbs 11:28 The wicked man's fears will come true, and so will the good man's hopes.

Philippians. 1:6 But he who has begun a good work in you will continue until the day that Jesus comes.

Ephesians 2:8 For by GRACE are you saved through FAITH, and that not of yourself, it is the GIFT of God.

Psalms 37:4 Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.

Psalms 118:1 O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: because his mercy endures for ever.

Psalms 116:4-9 Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD has dealt bountifully with thee. For You have delivered my soul from death, my eyes from tears, and my feet from falling. I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living.

Psalms 116:4-5 I called upon the name of the LORD; O LORD, I implore you, deliver my soul. Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; our God is merciful. The

LORD preserves the simple: I was brought low, and he helped me.

Psalms 36:9 For with You, Lord, is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light.

Psalms 40:4 Blessed happy is the man who makes the Lord his trust.

Psalms 31:19 Oh, how great is Your goodness which You have laid up for those who love you, Which you have prepared for those who trust in you.

Psalms 32 10-11 But he who trusts in the Lord, mercy shall surround him. Be glad in the Lord and rejoice, you righteous.

Lev 26:6 KJV And I will give peace in the land, and you shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land.

Num 6:26 KJV The LORD lift up his countenance upon you, and give you peace.

Psalms 34:14 KJV Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it.

Psalms 37:11 KJV But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

Psalmsa 37:37 KJV Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright: for the end of

that man is peace.

Psalms 55:18 KJV He has delivered my soul in peace from the battle that was against me: for there were many with me.

Psalms 119:165 KJV Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

Proverbs 3:2 KJV For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

Proverbs 3:17 KJV Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace.

Proverbs 12:20 KJV Deceit is in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counselors of peace is joy.

Proverbs 16:7 KJV When a man's ways please the LORD, he makes even his enemies to be at peace with him.

Proverbs 17:28 KJV Even a fool, when he holds his peace, is counted wise: and he that shuts his lips is esteemed a man of understanding.

Isaiah 9:6 KJV For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Isaiah 9:7 KJV Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Isaiah 26:3 KJV Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusts in thee.

Isaiah 26:12 KJV LORD, thou wilt ordain peace for us: for thou also hast wrought all our works in us.

Isaiah 27:5 KJV Or let him take hold of my strength, that he may make peace with me; and he shall make peace with me.

Isaiah 32:17 KJV And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance forever.

Isaiah 38:17 KJV Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but thou hast in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: for thou hast cast all my sins

behind thy back.

Isaiah 39:8 KJV Then said Hezekiah to Isaiah, Good is the word of the LORD which thou hast spoken. He said moreover, For there shall be peace and truth in my days.

Isaiah 48:18 KJV O that thou hadst hearkened to my commandments! then had thy peace been as a river, and thy righteousness as the waves of the sea:

Isaiah 48:22 KJV There is no peace, saith the LORD, unto the wicked.

Isaiah 52:7 KJV How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that brings good tidings, that publishes peace; that brings good tidings of good, that publishes salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigns!

Isaiah 53:5 KJV But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Isaiah 54:10 KJV For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the LORD that hath mercy on thee.

Isaiah 54:13 KJV And all thy children shall be taught of the LORD; and great shall be the peace of thy children.

Isaiah 55:12 KJV **For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace:** the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

Isaiah 57:2 KJV He shall enter into peace: they shall rest in their beds, each one walking in his uprightness.

Isaiah 57:19 KJV **I create the fruit of the lip; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, saith the LORD; and I will heal him.**

Isaiah 57:21 KJV There is no peace, says my God, to the wicked.

Isaiah 59:8 KJV The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goes therein shall not know peace.

Isaiah 60:17 KJV For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness.

Jer 14:13 KJV Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! behold, the prophets say unto them, Ye shall not see the sword, neither shall ye have famine; **but I will give you assured peace in this place.**

NKJV Jer 29:11 KJV For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

NLT Je 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you,” says the LORD. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

Jer 33:6 KJV Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth.

Ezek 37:26 KJV Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.

Nahum 1:15 KJV Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace! O Judah, keep thy solemn feasts, perform thy vows: for the wicked shall no more pass through thee; he is utterly cut off.

Mal 2:6 KJV The law of truth was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity.

Mark 4:39 KJV And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

Mark 5:34 KJV And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

Mark 9:50 KJV Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace one with another.

Mark 10:48 KJV And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou son of David, have mercy on me.

Luke 1:79 KJV To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

Luke 2:14 KJV Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

Luke 2:29 KJV Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word:

Luke 4:35 KJV And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.

Luke 7:50 KJV And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.
